***OUR BIG IDEA:** “Remember, there’s a right way to go!”

A. HERE ARE SOME STEPS TO TAKE—*TO GO WITH THE GOSPEL:*

• Colossians 4:1-6

1. (V1-2) Start **DEVELOPING** A PRAYER LIFE

- **devoted means** to be faithful and steadfast; **thanksgiving is** to express gratitude to God

2. (V3) Then pray for **DOORS TO OPEN:**

- **open:** give opportunity to publish the gospel & make converts; **door:** present opportunity; give free access; **word:** *Logos*—Christ; **mysteries:** that Gentiles can be fellow heirs of the Gospel; the **mystery** is that it’s for ALL NATIONS

3. (V4) When the doors open pray to **DO IT RIGHT**

- **make it clear:** make it apparent; make it known; to show openly; **way it ought:** the way it’s necessary; the way it’s inevitable

4.(V5) After prayer has paved the way then we **WISELY GO**

- **wisdom:** best plans, best means; sound judgment & good sense; **make the most:** redeem time; gaining or protracting time; to buy all that is anywhere to be bought

5.(V6) When you’re going always respond **WITH GRACE (TO ALL)**

- **grace:** gracefulness; acceptableness; **respond:** to answer or return an answer with discretion
