How will it look?

HERE’S OUR (4) “S.T.I.R. STEPS”

STEP ONE: Personal Reflection, Repentance & Readiness—This is a time for quiet and personal reflection of God’s goodness, personal repentance of sin, personal readiness of one’s heart to serve and meet God during our Worship Services.

STEP TWO: Prayers of Community Repentance, Turning-away & Returning—This is a time to ask God’s forgiveness for Community (Church) disobedience, turning-away from our sins, and proclaiming to return back to God through obedience.

STEP THREE: Prayers Against Works of Darkness—This is where we “Bind the Strong Man” and the works of darkness that would try to hinder the move of God’s Spirit in the midst of our Worship Services and Communities.

STEP FOUR: Prayers Requesting the Move God—This is where we ask the Holy Spirit to move and do His transformational work in the hearts and lives of His people—the Church.
