1. (4:1-14) Remember the **COMMANDS** OF GOD:

3. (6:15-16a & 7:6-8a) Remember the **JEALOUSY** OF GOD

4. (18:1-5) Remember the **SERVANTS** OF GOD

- **Key Verse(s):** 1 Timothy 5:17; 1 Corinthians 9:7-15
- **Key Word(s):** honor: compensation; remuneration; that which is paid in honor of another's work; an honorarium or wage; hope: the expectation of good;) sacred services: services inspired by God and pertaining to God; get their living: to sustain life; to live on or by anything

5. (26:1-4 then 9-13) Remember the **SACREDNESS** OF GENEROSITY:

- **Key Verse(s):** Philippians 4:15-17; 2 Corinthians 9:6-8
- **Key Word(s):** paying all: to tithe (the whole); the tenth part of (any/all); increase: your harvest or yield; it is also your revenue; income or gain of any kind; sacred: set-apartness; holiness; profit: the advantage; the fruit; increases: to cause to have much; to exist in abundance; to make to increase; to have more than enough; your account: *logos*; your intelligence; your reasoning as the power of the soul; *the Christ* or the spiritual, divine nature of Christ; bountifully: blessing; favorably; generously; a gift; abundance: to cause to abound; to make overflow

6. (31:24-30 & 32:1-44) Remember to **SING**:

- **Key Verse(s):** Psalm 100:1-5; John 4:20-24
- **Key Word(s):** provoking to anger: to be vexed; grieved; syn.: aggravated; irritated; displeased; annoyed
