A. A MULTIPLYING CHURCH IS A DISCIPLE MAKING CHURCH... Matthew 28:16-20

- 1. (V17-18) We're people TRUSTING CHRIST'S AUTHORITY
- **Key Word (s):** <u>all authority</u>: all power of choice; all liberty of doing as one pleases; all the power of influence and of privilege.

2. (V19a) We're people MAKING DISCIPLES OF ALL NATIONS

• **Key Word (s):** <u>disciples</u>: a learner, pupil; not only to learn but to become attached to one's teacher; and to become his follower in doctrine and conduct of life; <u>all</u> <u>the nations</u>: <u>all the tribes</u> or <u>all the people groups</u>.

3. (V19b-20a) We're people **TEACHING** OBEDIENCE

• **Key Word (s):** <u>teaching</u>: to impart instruction; to explain; expound a thing; <u>obeylobservelfollow</u>: to tend to carefully; to take care of; to guard *all that I have commanded you*.

B.A MULTIPLYING CHURCH IS <u>A DEPOSITING CHURCH</u>: 2 Timothy 2:1-2

1. (V1) We give **BIRTH** TO SPIRITUAL OFFSPRING

• **Key Word (s):** <u>my son</u>: my offspring; this name transferred to that intimate and reciprocal relationship formed between men by the bonds of love, friendship, trust, just as between parents and children; Also in the NT, disciples are called children of their teachers, because by their instruction nourish the minds of their pupils and mold their characters.

2. (V2a) We give the **FAITHFUL OPPORTUNITIES TO DISCIPLE**

• **Key Word (s):** <u>entrust</u>: to deposit; to set before; food places on a table to commit to one's charge; <u>entrust these to faithful</u>: of persons who show themselves faithful in the <u>transaction of business</u>, the <u>execution of commands</u>, or the <u>discharge of official duties</u>; <u>worthy of trust</u>; <u>can be relied on</u>; <u>easily persuaded</u>; one who <u>trusts in God's promises</u>; one who is <u>convinced that Jesus has been raised from the dead</u>; one who has become <u>convinced that Jesus is the Messiah and author of salvation</u>.

3. (V2b) We give the ABLE OPPORTUNITIES TO TEACH

• **Key Word (s):** <u>able</u>: sufficient in ability; fit *to teach*; <u>teach</u>: to be a teacher; to discharge the office of a teacher, conduct one's self as a teacher; to impart instruction; instill doctrine into one; to explain or expound a thing; to teach one something; to hold discourse with others in order to instruct them; deliver didactic discourses.

- 1. Are you trusting in *Christ's authority to help you make disciples*? **If not, why?**
- 2. Are you making disciples who are *more attached to Christ* or attached to you? **Why or why not?**
- 3. Are you convinced that making disciples is for all nations? Why or why not?
- 4.Are you giving the *able opportunities to make disciples* who make disciples? **If not, why?**
