A. WHAT IS THE *ONE* REQUIREMENT FOR BAPTISM? Acts 8:26-39

- A. (V37) Like the Ethiopian eunuch the only requirement for baptism is to **BELIEVE!**
- **Key Word (s): believe:** to think to be true; to be persuaded; to place confidence in.

B. BELIEVE WHAT? Isaiah 53:1-11

1. (V2) **Believe** that Jesus Christ **CAME FOR YOU**

2. (V3-9) **Believe** that He **SUFFERED & DIED FOR YOU**

3. (V10-11) And **Believe** that He **CONQUERED THE GRAVE FOR YOU**

C. SO, HOW DO YOU PREPARE YOURSELF FOR BAPTISM?

• **Let's go back to Acts 8:36-37**

1. (V37) First, **BELIEVE WITH ALL YOUR HEART**

2. (V36) Second, **FIND WATER**
