# A. HOW CAN WE ENSURE SPACE IS AVAILABLE FOR YOUR GOOD WORKS?

- •1 Corinthians 12:1-31
- A. (V1-6) Remember there's only ONE SOURCE FOR YOUR WORKS
- в. (V7\*-10) Your good works are always for the **COMMON** GOOD
- c. (V11) Your good works are GIVEN JUST AS HE WILLS
- D. (V12-13) Your good works are for ALL PEOPLE
- **E.(V14-21)** Your good works should fulfill the **NEEDS OF ALL**
- Key Word (s): no need: no necessity; no duty of you or to you
- Key Verse (s): 1 Peter 4:10-11

- **F.(V22-25)** Your good works are given to **UNIFY THE BODY**
- **Key Word (s):** <u>no division</u>: no dissension; to split into factions
- Key Verse (s): Ephesians 2:19-22; Ephesians 4:11-16
