## A. HOW SHOULD YOUR WORKS EXPRESS LOVE WITHIN THE CHURCH?

- Galatians 5:1-14: (V13) "...but through (by the means of) <u>love</u> serve one another."
  - Key Word (s): <u>love</u> (agape): God doing what He knows is best for man not necessarily what man desires; not what man wanted but what God knew man needed; <u>serve</u>: doing what the occasion demands.
- Galatians 5:13-6:9
  - A. (5:13-15) Your works should never **DESTROY**
  - Key Word (s): <u>consume</u>: to expend; use up, destroy; <u>bite</u>: to wound the soul; <u>devour</u>: ruin, inflict injuries, consume strength of body and mind by strong emotions.
  - Key Verse (s): 1 Corinthians 14:12; Romans 15:1-2: Romans 14:18-19

- B. (5:16-26) Your works must be SPIRIT-LED
- Key Word (s): walk by: to direct one's life by the Holy Spirit; to live by the Spirit; in order to keep you from doing: in order to keep you from producing, constructing, forming whatever you want; in order to keep you from causing one to do whatever you want; challenging: provoke; to call forth; envying: pain felt at the sight of excellence.
- Key Verse (s): Romans 7:14-26
