A. HOW SHOULD YOUR WORKS EXPRESS LOVE WITHIN THE CHURCH?

- Galatians 5:1-14: (V13) "...but through (by the means of) love serve one another."
- **Key Word (s):** <u>love</u> (agape): God doing what He knows is best for man not necessarily what man desires; not what man wanted but what God knew man needed; **serve:** doing what the occasion demands.
- Galatians 5:13-6:10
 - A. (5:13-15) Your works should never **DESTROY**
 - B. (5:16-26) Your works must be SPIRIT-LED
 - C. (6:1) Your works should LOVINGLY RESTORE
 - D. (6:2) Your works should be **SUPPORTIVE**
 - E. (6:3-4) Your works seek to AVOID PRIDE
 - F. (6:5) Your works should assume a RESPONSIBLE LOAD
 - **Key Word (s):** <u>own load</u>: this is from the Greek word <u>phortion</u>, <u>which means</u> responsibility; to assume responsibility of life; don't shirk your responsibilities.
 - Key Verse (s): Ephesians 4:9-16

G. (6:6) Your works should BENEFIT YOUR TEACHER

- **Key Word (s):** <u>share **good things**</u>: <u>share</u> useful, pleasant, joyful <u>things</u>; <u>share</u> benefits; <u>share</u> excellent <u>and</u> distinguished <u>things</u>.
- Key Verse (s): Hebrews 13:17

H. (6:7-9) Your works should one day REAP A GOOD HARVEST

- **Key Word (s):** <u>he will also reap</u> either to reap a harvest; cut off or destroy; in <u>due</u> <u>time</u>: appointed time; a fixed and definite time or season; a limited amount of time; <u>if you don't grow weary</u>: if you don't grow exhausted or cease to be able.
- Key Verse (s): Hebrews 12:1-4
